Sports Day

Sports day will consist of track events such as sprints, egg and spoon as well as sack race. All children who are spectating will be sat in their classes. Parents, grandparents, family members and parents are invited to come and watch should they wish to. All visitors will be signed onto the site via the side gate on the playground.
