Next week, Y5 have some exciting activities to look forward to and I would like to remind you of some of the details.

Ancient Greece Workshop - Monday 16th March

On Monday is their Ancient Greece Workshop where they will experience a range of Ancient Greek related activities including Greek theatre, the Olympic Games, democracy and an Ancient Greek battle.

Children may come dressed as an Ancient Greek for the day, but this is optional. There are plenty of ideas on the internet to help with this.

Bikeability Level 2 - Wednesday 18th & Thursday 19th March

Children will gain a comprehensive knowledge of positioning, signalling, negotiating a variety of junctions and general road safety awareness whilst completing their Bikeability training. On both days please provide your child with the following:

- A suitable bike
- Bicycle Helmet
- Gloves are advised
- Warm, waterproof clothing - children should come to school on both days in their own clothes, not their uniform.
- Healthy morning snack, suitable to carry in a pocket

On both mornings, bikes should be brought into school via the side driveway and will be stored securely in the staff carpark until required. You may provide a plastic bag to act as a seat cover in case of rain. Those children who cannot easily bring bikes back and forth to school each day are able to leave them at school overnight, where they will be held within the staff carpark area to the rear of school. Bikes left overnight should be securely locked with your own bicycle lock. Please be aware, school cannot take responsibility for them and they are left at the owner's risk.
