

# Flying Bird Mobile

*Make your own bird mobile with a gentle flapping motion. In this video, Thingumajig Theatre director, Andrew Kim will show you step by step how to transform common household items like cardboard, string and paper into an animated bird. If you have paints, you can choose to paint the bird or you can colour it with torn pieces of paper, newspaper or magazines.*

## MATERIALS LIST

- Cardboard (like a delivery box)
- Cereal box (or similar)
- Paper (white office paper and/or tissue paper)
- Magazines (optional)
- PVA
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Masking tape
- Desk stapler
- Nail
- String or twine
- 2 x 50 pence coins
- 1 flat washer or 10 pence coin
- Stick
- Paint brush
- Plastic container for water and glue (such as a margarine or yogurt tub)
- Marker or paint (optional)
- Plastic or newspaper to cover your work area
