Your child's nasal spray flu vaccine is now due.

The children's nasal spray flu vaccine is safe and effective. It's offered every year to children to help protect them against <u>flu</u>.

Flu can be an unpleasant illness and can cause serious complications. Children can catch and spread flu easily. Vaccinating your child also protects vulnerable family members and friends. This winter there may be a rebound in flu levels, following low levels during the past 2 years because of pandemic restrictions.

The vaccination is free and is a quick, simple, and painless spray up the nose. Even if your child had the vaccine last year, types of flu can vary, so it is recommended to have it annually to maximise protection. Since the flu vaccine programme was introduced, most children offered the vaccine in schools have received the flu nasal spray annually.

To consent to your child having the nasal spray flu vaccine please complete the e-consent form via the link below, using the code for your child's school.
