Dear Parents and carers

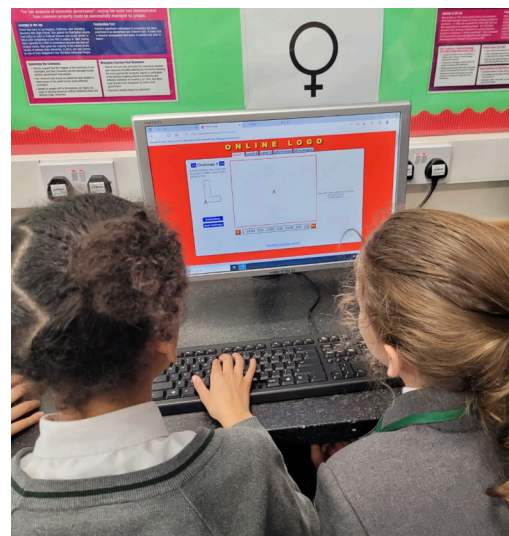
Despite it being close to the end of the first half term there are still lots of fantastic learning opportunities and activities taking place at Bunbury school.

Car Parking and Speeding

As we have all returned back to school I am very mindful of the parking situation once more outside school. Please can I encourage, where possible, all children to either walk or cycle to school and that this message is shared within your families for all those responsible for dropping off or collecting children from school. This week I have unfortunately needed to sent a reminder out to parents about parking particularly when it is wet after a complaint from a local resident.

Where children need to be travelling by car please can I ask that you park considerably around the surrounding area **even when the weather is wet** for example by:

- **not blocking residents driveways**
- **not parking on the pavement**
- **not parking on corners of roads**
- **not parking in areas where it makes it difficult for children to cross or forces them to walk on the road.**
- **not parking opposite the school entrance or zig zag lines**
- **not parking in the minibus zone unless displaying a disability badge**

Cones have now been placed opposite the school to ensure that this area is kept free of cars.


