Internet Matters has a huge range of advice from social media settings to home filtering.

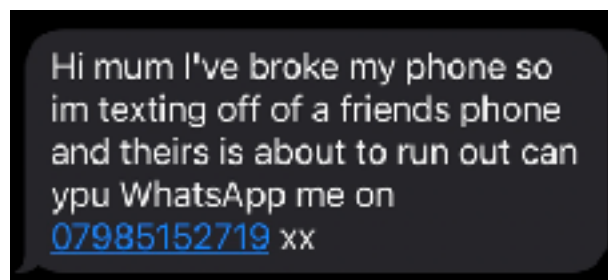

Amazon Smile

To activate Amazon smile in the app:



1. Open and login to the Amazon app
2. Press the menu icon (bottom right)
3. Scroll past all the product categories and choose Settings from the menu
4. Choose Amazon Smile from the menu
5. Click turn on Amazon Smile
6. Search Bunbury and choose The Aldersey School Association as your chosen charity
7. Follow the steps to activate Amazon Smile (it will ask you to turn on notifications, this is required to use Amazon Smile)
8. Once you've activated Amazon Smile, you shop as normal and money is raised for the school automatically
