- 4. Choose Amazon Smile from the menu
- 5. Click turn on Amazon Smile
- 6. Search Bunbury and choose The Aldersey School Association as your chosen charity
- 7. Follow the steps to activate Amazon Smile (it will ask you to turn on notifications, this is required to use Amazon Smile)
- 8. Once you've activated Amazon Smile, you shop as normal and money is raised for the school automatically
