| <p><b>Art/DT:</b> Make a model of a dragon or create an image of a dragon.</p>   | <p><b>Music:</b> Create a "fire song" or a piece of music that could represent a dragon flying over a burning city. Use household items to create fire-like sounds (e.g., clapping for crackling fire, tapping for dragon wings, etc.). Record your song or perform it to the class.</p> | <p><b>Geography:</b> Look at birds-eye view image of London. Can you label key landmarks that we have looked at in class? E.g. River Thames, Tower Bridge, St Paul's Cathedral, London Bridge.</p>      |
| <p><b>Reading:</b> Visit the library and find a book about the Great Fire of London. Read and enjoy the book.</p> <p>Perhaps you could record your favourite fact from the book on a poster?</p> | <p><b>DT:</b> Design a fire-resistant house. Think about what materials might have been used to build houses in 1666 compared to what is used today. Share your design as a labelled diagram or in a booklet.</p> <p><b>You could even make your design!</b></p>                         | <p><b>Maths/PE:</b> The length of the area affected by The Great Fire of London was 1 1/2 miles. Walk 1 1/2 miles to see how big the fire was! How long did it take you? How many steps did you do?</p> |
