Registering

Parent/Carers wishing to send their child/children to sessions at 'Bunbury Badgers' can now self-book & pay online via 'Schoolmoney'. **Please be aware payment is required at the time of booking.**

If your child/children are **attending 'Bunbury Badgers' for the first time please ensure that you telephone the school office or email our RCSAT wraparound-care manager, who will provide you with club's access information ready for their session.**

With any concerns regarding your child/children settling into 'Bunbury Badgers' please discuss this with our Academy, wraparound-care Manager, Gillian Corbett-Mills who will be happy to work with you.

Absence

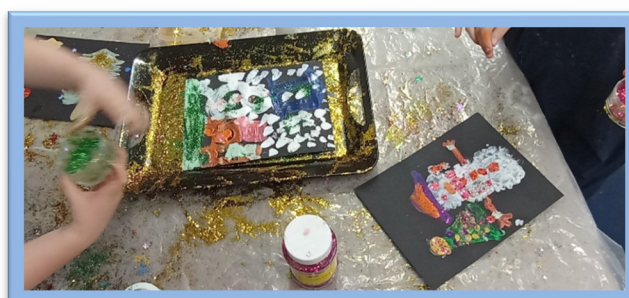
'Bunbury Badgers' fees will be reviewed annually.

Illness

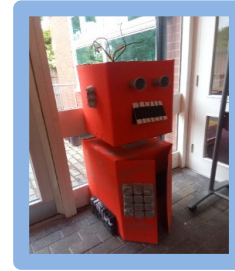
Behaviour

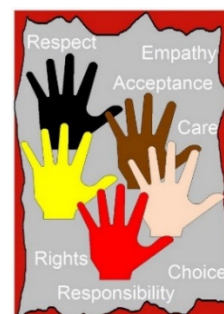
