### Children In Need Rickshaw Challenge – Monday 11<sup>th</sup> November 2019

As you may be aware the Rickshaw Challenge will be passing directly outside Bunbury Primary School on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> November. We have been notified by the organisers that the cyclists are expected to arrive at approximately 2.47pm. They would also like as many spectators as possible to line the road outside school to support the team and cheer them on. As we do not want the children to miss out on this fantastic opportunity, we have taken the decision to unofficially close school at 2.30pm. In doing this, we ask for as many parent/carers as possible, **to collect their child/ren from the rear of school at 2.30pm, then line along School Lane outside school ready for the Rickshaw and convoy.** If you are travelling by car, following school collection we ask for all vehicles to be removed from School lane, alleviating traffic congestion in good time for the cyclist's arrival. We appreciate an earlier collection may not be possible for all parent/carers. Therefore, staff members will escort and supervise those remaining pupils to the front of school to see the Rickshaw and cyclists pass by. However, they will remain on school grounds. Due to the nature of the event, delays may be possible. With this in mind, we will be tracking the team's progress throughout the day and will update you via text accordingly. If you are notified of a delay whereby the Rickshaw Challenge will pass through Bunbury later than 3.30pm, school will not close early. We will close at the normal time and collection will also be at the normal time. Again you will receive a text notification if this is the case.
