## Years 3 and 5 Residential Trip (22<sup>nd</sup> - 24<sup>th</sup> June 2020)

We have arranged a two night residential trip for Years 3 and 5, in the summer term of 2020, at the Edgmond Hall Centre for Outdoor Learning in Shropshire. We will leave school on the morning of Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> June, returning on Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> June, before the end of the school day. We will also hold a parent/carer meeting nearer to the time to provide you with more information.

The children will have the opportunity to try out a range of outdoor activities. Residential courses are recognised as a valuable part of the curriculum as is the beneficial effect that learning outside the classroom has on a child's progress.

The children will take part in outdoor pursuits, which will pose new and exciting challenges for them. They will learn to work together as a team, develop further independence, confidence and an ability to recognise strengths and weaknesses in a constructive way. The centre offers a wide range of activities. A more detailed timetable of these will be made available nearer the time. At the Edgmond Hall Centre for Outdoor Learning, fully trained and qualified instructors, with the support of school staff, will provide instruction on a full programme of activities in a safe and controlled environment. The total cost of the trip is £165.00 and includes: full board and accommodation, return transport from school to the centre, all instruction, activities and safety equipment, a programme of evening activities, achievement certificates and comprehensive insurance.
