We meet once every half term, usually after pick up on the third Tuesday after the holidays, for about an hour (several children come and keep themselves entertained during the meeting!). Each year is represented by two volunteers - a list of the current reps is included below. These volunteers liaise with other families in their class before the meetings to find out what concerns or points need to be raised - anything from uniform and birthday cakes to sports selection and praise for special moments.
