



Bunbury Parent Survey March 2022



As a school, we are never complacent and are always looking at ways we can make our provision for the children the very best it can be. I welcome all comments both positive and negative and always look to act on those I feel will benefit all the children of Bunbury. Recently we asked our parents/carers to complete a survey which asked a number of key questions regarding the school's current provision.

In total **36 / 124** families completed the survey which is about 30% of the school. The results and responses to the survey have been analysed as follows:
