Today we ended our Spring term history theme and began our celebrations for the Platinum Jubilee with a decades week. During this week each class

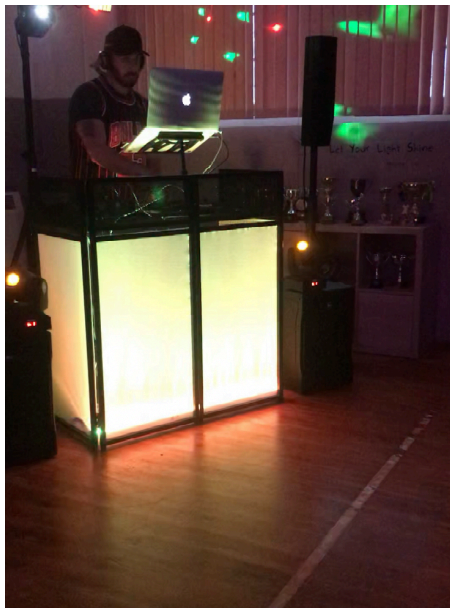

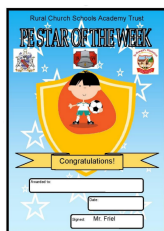
