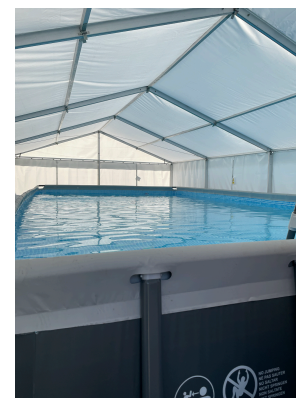
Isaiah 41:10
