# Read Write Inc.




- ▶ Daily Phonics lessons are taught using the Read, Write Inc. scheme.
- ▶ Each letter has a rhyme, which also helps support correct letter formation.
- ▶ Reading books are based on this scheme and are matched to the sounds that the children know. This ensures children can segment and blend all the words in the book.



# Mathematics



- ▶ We follow the White Rose Scheme - Mastery approach.
- ▶ Range of different experiences.
- ▶ Number blocks to introduce concepts.
- ▶ Outdoor learning.
- ▶ A combination of structured activities and classroom maths resources for children to select and use independently.
- ▶ Numicon - concrete and visual representation of number.



# Continuous Provision

The purpose of continuous provision is "to *continue the provision for learning in the absence of an adult*".

- If your child requires medication in school hours a permission form will need to be completed in the office.






# Home Learning
