Another week has flown by and I can't believe we are so close to the end of the school year. Around school there is still an excitement to our learning, although we are all sounding a little tired. We forget that this is the first full year we have had in school since 2019!

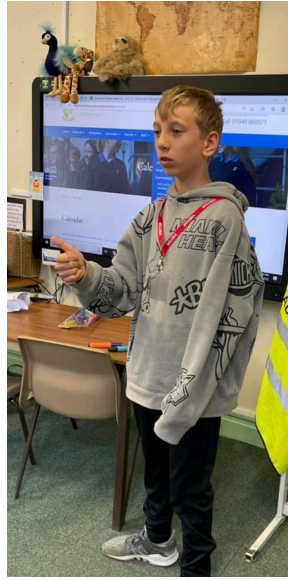
It has been fantastic to hear our year 6 children rehearsing for their end of year celebrations and play. Key Stage 2 SATs results arrived this week and we have now been able to share these with parents along with the Year 4 multiplication test, KS1 SATs and Year 1 phonic tests. I am incredibly proud of all our children's achievements.

Whilst we may all have very different views on the place of testing within the primary curriculum the testing process for these children was kept in perspective. All the staff at Bunbury ensured that the children were prepared adequately so that they could achieve their potential but not at the expense of their mental health and well-being. I know that through the year they have all worked incredibly hard deepening their learning in preparation for

these tests and I am extremely proud of each and everyone of them. They all need to be congratulated for their progress and the standards they have achieved.

As their head teacher, and a parent, I know that it is not easy being tested as a child at any age but there is something we all need to remember when looking at our children's results. None of the tests listed above measure what makes your child special and unique. They do not know that they sing, dance and are extremely creative. They do not measure how kind they are to their friends or how they look after their classmates. They do not know how far they can run, how well they can ride a horse or how many goals they have scored. They do not know that they have overcome hurdles and obstacles in their life especially over the past 2 years with the covid disruption and they certainly do not test how special, unique and amazing they are as individuals.

The results from these tests will tell you something, but not everything.



On Monday we welcomed Max a year 7 pupil from Bishop Heber to come and talk to our Year 6 pupils about life in their new school from September. Max is one of our past pupils and we are incredibly proud of what he has achieved during the past 12 months - he is a shining example of an ex Bunbury pupil. The previous week we welcomed Lucy a year 11 pupil from Tarporley who again spoke to our children about life at Tarporley next year. We thank both of these young people for giving up their time to support, encourage and inform our primary school leavers.

We also welcomed 2 new pupils to our school this week Oliver (Year 4) and Isobel (Year 3). We hope you will be very happy in your new school and we look forward to making you a part of Bunbury school family.

Yesterday we were also treated to a piano concert by our Year 6 musicians. William, Harriet and Finn shared their musical talents with the rest of their class. It was so lovely to hear how far they have progressed with their piano skills during their years of music lessons at Bunbury.

Each week on a Friday one of talented Bunbury musicians plays the whole school into our worship. It is such a fantastic way to celebrate their talents but also a fitting start to our weekly celebration worship.



Today we held our first Rural Church Schools Academy Trust Ethos conference at Bunbury. Our Ethos teams from across the trust gathered together to explore the value of HOPE. We welcomed Rev Tim for an opening worship and Beth Hayward for a Forest Church session before reflecting on what HOPE meant to us and completing some craft and art activities to take back to our schools. We look forward to making this an annual event across the trust.

STAR Day (Success, Targets And Reflection)

As you may be aware from our newsletter diary dates, Star Day is scheduled for Thursday 14th July, 2pm-4pm. This is the first time we have been able to hold the event for 2 years and we are delighted that Star Day is returning in it's original form. At 2pm you are invited to celebrate your child's achievements, share books and learning. The aim is to enable parents and carers to discuss their child's achievements, evaluate progress and discuss next steps in learning with your child so that we are all working together to ensure the best outcomes. You can come in at any time between 2-4pm to do this. We will ask you to complete a short form with your child as you discuss their work which identifies what your child has been successful at as well as targets you can create together. The aim is to work in partnership with you and co-create effective and achievable targets for your child and also to reflect on the progress they have made this year. We hope that the afternoon will be an enjoyable and supportive experience for all involved.

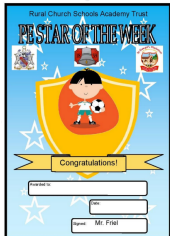
Some may believe that we should be going into a competition to win with the strongest team. However we all know that part of becoming a good well rounded sports person is learning that you may not win each time and to work as a team.

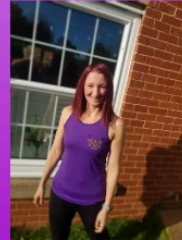
